AT A GLANCE

LOCATION Located in the heart of the Lupanda GMA, on the banks of the Luangwa River, it is ideally located to explore both the Park and the Nsefu sector.

GPS 13°03'58.0" S 31°50'38.5" E

AIR ACCESS Access to Shawa Luangwa Camp is best by plane from Lusaka (1 hour) to Mfuwe International Airport followed by a one-hour transfer drive into camp, of which the last 30 minutes is already into the stunning scenery of the Lupanda GMA.

Lusaka – Mfuwe Airport – 1 hour.

ACCESS BY ROAD Lusaka – Luangwa 9.5 hours (MFUWE – SOUTH LUANGWA NATIONAL PARK. I

VISA Most passports require a visa. These can be obtained in advance or arrival at Kenneth Kaunda International Airport.

CURRENCY Zambia Kwacha (ZMW). USD cash is widely accepted in Zambia.

SEASONS **Summer** – August to April with October and November being very hot.
Winter – May to August. Evenings are cool and mornings very cold.

RAINS November to March. Rains are sometimes experienced in April.

MALARIA Malaria is prevalent across Zambia. Please consult your doctor for recommended prophylaxis.

YELLOW FEVER No longer needed to transit through SA.

WHAT SETS US APART?

South Luangwa National park in itself sets our camp apart from all the other areas, the valley of the leopards is truly something special.

As Jacob says, no two days are the same and each day is a new discovery.

We've introduced the first ever silent safaris to the South Luangwa National Park. Our electric Landcruiser's allow you to sneak up on the famous oxbow lagoons without startling the game going about their normal routines.

Shawa was also named after our famous Jacob who has spent his life guiding these paths and will undoubtedly show you everything South Luangwa has to offer.



LODGE FACILITIES

TENTED NESTS

All 5 luxury tents are elevated off the ground with expansive views of the Luangwa River and the park beyond. Bathrooms are en suite with showers enclosed with a shower curtain and toilets in separate cubicles. There are double vanities with brass and copper fittings.

3 luxury double tents that can be converted to twin beds. 2 connected tents, one with a king bed and the other with twin beds, can be used as a family tent or sold separately. They are separated by a 5m elevated walkway. Each tent has its own private deck.

Filter coffee, a variety of tea and cookies are provided. Hot water is delivered early morning by flask and can be delivered at any time of the day on request.

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CHILDREN	All ages allowed. Valet can act as babysitter.
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POOL	Yes.
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DISABLED ACCESS	The main building has ramp access and game drives can take place from the lodge where disabled clients can be comfortably accommodated in the front of game drive vehicle. Staff will assist the guest in accessing the vehicle. One tent conveniently located close to the main building has ramp access and the shower and toilet has sufficient space to work with a wheelchair. Shower chairs available.

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DINING AREA AND BAR

Our open-air dining room overlooks the Luangwa River and breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea and dinner are served daily. A modern international cuisine is served with the option of local dishes on request. These are set menus, but all dietary requirements can be catered for.

A light early morning snack is provided before game drives and light snacks and drinks are provided on all activities.

Dining is by individual seating arrangement, but guests are welcome to invite their guide or management to join them. They are also welcomed to dine with other guests.

The bar, lounge and dining area overlook the Luangwa River and is located in a multi-levelled tented building well elevated off the ground maximizing views. A great variety of drinks are served including a superb wine list and cocktails.

PRIVATE DINING	Yes – various locations available on request. Meals can also be served in your tent PRIVATE DINNER on request.
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FENCED	No
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SECURITY	24-Hour Security
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VEHICLES	2 x electric Land Cruiser Game Drive vehicles each configured to seat 6 but converted to 9 for groups and families.
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1 x diesel transfer vehicle.

TENT FACILITIES

EXTRA BEDS	Yes, subject to availability and only suitable for children 12 years old and younger.
FAN	Yes, in all tents.
SECURITY	24-Hour Security
AC/HEATER	No, Evenings cool down to comfortable temperatures even in the hottest months. Double feather duvets and hot water bottles are provided during the colder months.
MOSQUITO NET	Yes, in all tents.
BATH	Yes in all tents.
SHOWER	Yes, in all tents.
SAFE	Yes.
HAIRDRYER	No hairdryers in the tents due to power restrictions but can be provided on request.
LAUNDRY	Yes, but kindly note it is air dried so takes at least 24 hours. Laundry is complimentary for all-inclusive packages.
POWER	Shawa Safari Lodge is an eco-friendly lodge with mostly supplied by solar. 220v with built in multi plugs are available in all rooms.

ACTIVITIES

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Silent Safaris twice a day – at sunrise and in the evening. The evening drive returns 1.5 hours after dark. Children 6 and older are welcome on game drives but children younger than 6 may only attend drives if a private vehicle is available. This arrangement can only be made at the lodge and cannot be guaranteed in advance. Walking Safaris are available. A maximum of 6 people on a walking safari and the minimum age is 12 years old. Boating Safaris available based on water levels.

Bush Breakfast or Lunch in the bush are available.
